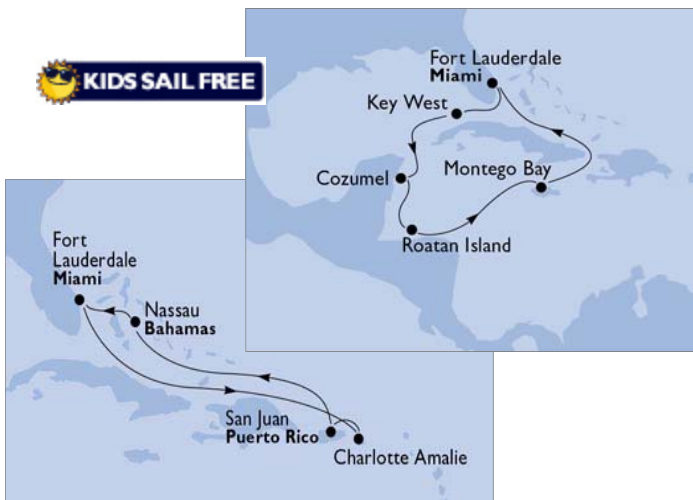

COZUMEL, MEXICO

Cozumel is Mexico's largest island, nestled just 12 miles off the coast of the Yucatan Peninsula. Cozumel is world renown for its dazzling white sandy beaches and the remarkable clarity of the multi-hued azure Caribbean ocean in which it rests. The climate is subtropical & the people native to Cozumel are of Mayan descent.

KEY WEST, FLORIDA

Key West's charm continues, though the pace of life has picked up quiet a bit in recent years. Hemingway's Sloppy Joe's draws tourists to its flamboyant lifestyle.

MONTEGO BAY, JAMAICA

Take a trip back in time and visit the classic plantation houses, including the spooky 18th-century Rose Hall Great House, home of the legendary Annie Palmer, the White Witch of Rose Hall. Feeling adventurous? Climb the world-famous 600-foot Dunn's River Falls waterfall or raft through the rainforest.

NASSAU, BAHAMAS

The capital Nassau, a fiscal haven, is rich in history, tradition, charm and folklore. Prized for its sheltered harbor, the city made history and preserved it beautifully in Victorian mansions, cathedrals, 18th-century fortresses and a Queen's Staircase.

ROATAN, HONDURAS

A small isle, almost 40 miles long and approximately two miles wide, Roatan's natural charms are abundant: in addition to the reef, there are mountains, forests and beautiful beaches ideal for swimming, snorkeling, glass-bottom boat rides and dolphin encounters at the Roatan Institute of Marine Sciences, where programs educate visitors about these intelligent marine creatures and promote conservation of them and their habitat.

ST. THOMAS, VIRGIN ISLANDS

St. Thomas is the busiest of the three United States Virgin Islands. With 28 square miles of lush

green hills and sandy beaches, St. Thomas and the nearby island of St. John see nearly 1.7 million visitors a year. It is the second largest and most sophisticated of the Virgin Islands with a strong Danish influence especially evident in Charlotte Amalie, the main town and capital. Its colorful history dates back at least several thousand years.

SAN JUAN, PUERTO RICO

The island's heritage has roots in Hispanic and Anglo cultures; both have left their mark on the local architecture and, as the tourist board claims, visitors will find '21st century conveniences in a 16th century setting'. This small island packs a punch with an incredibly diverse landscape. Sunny beaches give way to upland tropical rainforests. Year-old high-rises share the island with 300-year-old towns and 1,000-year-old trees. With over 300 miles of the most beautiful beaches in the Caribbean, a large tropical rain forest, and Dry Cactus forest filled with its charm and warm people, Puerto Rico really has something for everyone.
