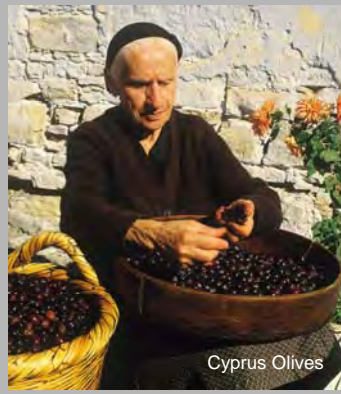

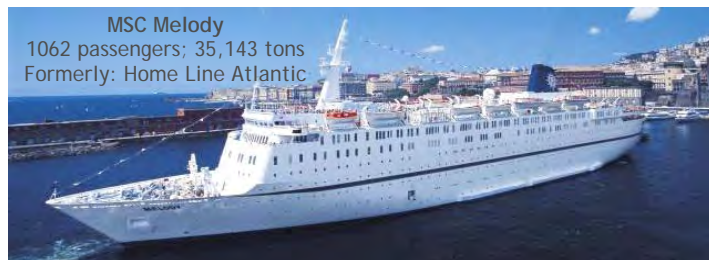

# ANCIENT ANTIQUITIES CRUISE FAM - PORTS OF CALL

## ALEXANDRIA, EGYPT

Designed by Greek architect Dinocrates (332-331 BC) on the site of an old village, Rhakotis, at the orders of Alexander the Great, the city, immortalizing Alexander's name, quickly flourished into a prominent cultural, intellectual, political, and economic metropolis. The remains of which are still evident to this day. From Alexandria you can take an optional full day tour to Cairo and the Great Pyramids.

## CIVITAVECCHIA (ROME), ITALY

From the port of Civitavecchia it is not far to the imposing ancient city of Rome, incomparable in terms of monuments, gardens, villas, and works of art: to name but a few, the Coliseum, the Capitol, Saint Peter's Basilica, ancient Ostia with the famous mosaics in the Baths of Neptune. Rome – where do we start? It is the ultimate vacation destination. There is perhaps no other city so crammed full of history, with layer upon layer of fabulous ruins, imperial temples...not to mention Etruscan tombs, early Christian churches, medieval bell towers, Renaissance palaces and baroque basilicas.

## GENOA, ITALY

A major commercial center. Its history dates back to 218 BC.

Today, the old town boasts narrow, busy streets with a typical Mediterranean ambiance.

## HAIFA, ISRAEL

A lovely seaport in its own right, Haifa is a departure point for Tel Aviv and Holy Land sightseeing. Jerusalem beckons with the Mount of Olives and the Western Wall. Jericho, Nazareth, Bethlehem, and the crusader city of Acre are also within reach.

## KATAKOLON (OLYMPIA), GREECE

Katakolon, a charming fishing village, is port to Olympia, a sacred precinct built for the quadrennial games dedicated to Zeus. From Katakolon you are within touching distance of where the Olympic Games started and the Olympic flame is still lit here every four years. Touring the sights of Olympia includes the Temple of Zeus and the original training ground for athletes.

## LIMASSOL, CYPRUS

A resort town in the Greek southern half of Cyprus, an island rich in history, lavished by the sun and lapped by the calm blue waters of the Eastern Mediterranean. The most popular excursions visit the sites of the Curium amphitheater and the sanctuary of Apollo, the Crusader castle at Kolossi and the House of Dionysus at Paphos.
