Galicia, Spain & France Cruise ♦ Ports of Call

AMSTERDAM, NETHERLANDS

One of the world's best hangouts, Amsterdam is a canny blend of old and new. The city seems to thrive on its funky mix and despite hordes of tourists, still manages to feel quintessentially Dutch. The old crooked houses, the cobbled streets, the tree-lined canals and generous parks all contribute to the atmosphere.

BILBOA, SPAIN

As the cultural heart of Spain's celebrated Basque country, the shining city of Bilbao is filled with Gothic architecture and landmarks that herald its centuries-old history. But more modern additions to this post-industrial port town, namely, the spectacular Guggenheim Museum, seem to draw the most attention.

ST. PETER PORT, GUERNSEY, UK

Originally a Viking settlement, a deep sense of history and tradition still pervades here. The Hebrides are home to close-knit communities, crofters and skilled artisan weavers, and to strong folk traditions and the lilting Gaelic dialect... to step onto the Isle of Lewis is to take time out from the hustle and bustle of the rest of the world. This sense of timelessness can be experienced at some of the island's key monuments.

LA CORUNA, SPAIN

The Home to the shrine of St. James the Apostle, Santiago de Compostela is the third holiest site in all Christendom. Pilgrims believed that making the journey here would reduce their sentence in purgatory by one-half. Your taste buds are in for a real treat here with octopus, oysters and scallops on the menu - Galicia's seafood is exquisite. If your taste is for history, feast on the views from the world's only working Roman lighthouse.

LA ROCHELLE, FRANCE

This resort town has beautifully preserved its historic charm. Lying on an inlet of the Bay of Biscay, its sandy beaches, lush landscape and sunny climate attracts millions of visitors a year, making La Rochelle one of the most visited cities in France. The two 14th century towers Tour de la Chaîne and the Tour Saint Nicolas flank the harbor and once helped protect and guard the city from invaders. Now it welcomes millions of visitors to its harbor. Also the core of the brandy trade is in Cognac, located about 50 miles from La Rochelle.

SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA, SPAIN

Make the most of your day in Santiago de Compostela and explore this wonderful city

in depth. Enjoy superb views of the typical Galician countryside on the transfer from port before reaching Santiago de Compostela, which is undoubtedly the showpiece of Galicia. The magnificent Santiago Cathedral is a monument to Christ's apostle, James, whose relics are believed to have been discovered here in the 9th century. The cathedral was once the third most important place of pilgrimage after Jerusalem and Rome and some half a million pilgrims flock here each year. Four majestic squares surround the Cathedral. Admire the majestic square of Plaza del Obradoiro, still the focal point for pilgrims when arriving in the city. Relax over luncheon and a glass of wine, served at the Parador Hostal de los Reyes Catolicos, a late 15th century pilgrim hostel, considered to be the oldest in the world.

SOUTHAMPTON, ENGLAND

Southampton has been a settlement since Roman and Saxon times. The Roman Ruins are situated in a suburb called Bitterne Manor. The town became walled in the medieval era, and some remnants of these defenses remain throughout the city. Southampton was devastated by bombing during the Second World War, so much of its architecture has quite a modern feel to it.
