ALEXANDRIA, EGYPT

The second largest city in Egypt, Alexandria has an atmosphere that is more Mediterranean than Middle Eastern; its ambiance and cultural heritage distance it from the rest of the country although it is only 225 km from Cairo. Founded by Alexander the Great in 331 B.C., Alexandria became the capital of Greco-Roman Egypt; its status as a beacon of culture is symbolized by Pharos, the legendary lighthouse that was one of the Seven Wonders of the World and the setting for the stormy relationship between Cleopatra and Mark Antony.

CIVITAVECCHIA, ITALY

From the port of Civitavecchia it is not far to the imposing ancient city of Rome, incomparable in terms of monuments, gardens, villas, and

works of art: to name but a few, the Coliseum, the Capitol, Saint Peter's Basilica, ancient Ostia with the famous mosaics in the Baths of Neptune.

GENOA, ITALY

Genoa is a leading Italian port, university town and a major commercial center. Its history dates back to 218 BC. when the city was founded by the Ligurians. Today, the old town boasts narrow, busy streets with a typical Mediterranean ambiance, while the new town features modern buildings, gardens and villas.

HAIFA, ISRAEL

A lovely seaport in its own right, Haifa is a departure point for Tel Aviv and Holy Land sightseeing. Jerusalem beckons with the Mount of Olives and the Western Wall. Jericho, Nazareth, Bethlehem, and

the crusader city of Acre are also within reach.

KATAKOLON, GREECE

From Katakolon you are within touching distance of where the Olympic Games started and the Olympic flame is still lit here every four years. Touring the sights of Olympia includes the Temple of Zeus and the original training ground for athletes.

LIMASSOL, CYPRUS

A resort town in the Greek southern half of Cyprus, an island rich in history, lavished by the sun and lapped by the calm blue waters of the Eastern Mediterranean. The most popular excursions visit the sites of the Curium amphitheater and the sanctuary of Apollo, the Crusader castle at Kolossi and the House of Dionysus at Paphos.
